Things to have for a booth

* Don't worry – check with your Team Leader for help to get you started!

Business/Vendor booth:

Tables (check to see if they are provided/extra)

Tablecloths – can get from Supplies in Back Office, or Amazon (I like to get nice black ones so the books really pop and then use a Table Drape from the Back Office and brightly colored crates from Wal-mart, or our colorful boxes)

Receipt book – from Supplies in Back Office (or one from Walmart in the Office section) **Money bag** with about \$100 in cash and some coins

Calculator

Drawing slips and sign - found in our Files on the Team page to print, or UBAM branded ones in the Supplies in Back Office

Pens

Bag/Container to collect drawing slips in

Plastic Bags – can use cheap Thank You bags from Amazon, or get thicker UBAM branded ones in the Supplies in Back Office

Business cards – from VistaPrint (in the Preferred Suppliers under Supplies in Back Office) **Flashlight** (if you have a Shine the light/Secrets book)

Recruiting brochures – from the Supplies in Back Office (they say "Join Us!") **Print**

- Current and next month Hostess Special if you have interest for a party
- Current Biz Kit Special to refer to if someone is curious about the biz

Calendar – have dates marked with "available" dates for online or home parties, just in case! **Water & Gum**

Optional:

Mini catalogs – a dozen or so to hand to customers interested in a party, or making a large purchase.

School Flyers- Early Learning, Elementary, and Secondary Education flyers. These are great as cheaper options to hand out to a daycare/preschool/school interested in the books we offer. Found in the Supplies in the Back Office.

Square register plug-in for taking credit cards (can also write down info on receipt and keep WHITE copy to enter in Order Pro later)

Banner – can be found in Supplies in Back Office

Tattoos, Stickers, Bookmarks – additions to offer customers/kids, if you'd like

Book Fair, Literacy for a Lifetime, and Cards for a Cause brochures – to have on hand in case you meet a connection from a school or business that is interested in our other programs.
